Grading:

Evaluation of in-water skills are performance based which means that you have not successfully completed the course until you are proficient in the skills required. The minimum standard is considered a starting point and skill proficiency is the completion point. Scientific Divers are expected to perform skills to demonstration level quality and serve as supervisors to Divers-in-Training. You must attend all courses in full to receive credit.
