Subject: Student Fee Advisory Committee Recommendations

Please find the following recommendations of the Student Fee Advisory Committee for FY26.

Committee Charge:

The Student Fee Advisory Committee (SFAC) is a committee charged with advising the administration on the type, amount, and expenditure of compulsory fees under Texas Education Code Section 54.503 for student service fees; Section 54.507 student health & medical services fee; Section 54.521 student center facilities and Section 54.539 recreational sports fee.

Action items:

Student Service fee: The student service is \$22.14 per semester credit hour (\$250.00 maximum). There is no request to increase this fee for FY26. New money generated by an increase in student head count and semester credit hours will fund any recommended increases in departmental budgets.

University Health Services fee: The health center fee is a flat fee of \$60.00 for each of the Fall & Spring semesters and \$25 per summer session. There is no request to increase this fee for FY26. New money generated by an increase in student head count and semester credit hours will fund any recommended increases in the University Health Center budget.

Student Center Complex fee: The current fee is a flat fee of \$100.00 per student per semester. There is no request to increase the fee for FY26. New money generated by an increase in student head count and semester credit hours will fund any recommended increases in the Student Center Complex budget.

Recreational Sports fee: The current fee is \$18/semester credit hour with a cap of \$175 for the fall and spring semesters. The maximum (cap) is \$87.50 for each summer session. There is no request to increase this fee for FY26. New money generated by an increase in student head count and semester credit hours will fund any recommended increases in the Recreational Sports budget.
